Tovala, App Subscription Management (2025)

3 month project designing new ways for save customers from canceling their meal plan by taking a short break.

- Evolved the concept from skipping individual weeks to a more intuitive “paused” state, thanks to strong design–dev collaboration
 - Took a business-driven opportunity and shaped it into an experience that had symbiotic user led benefits
- After 6 months we are seeing an increase in activity that is
- estimated at ~45k incremental orders or \$1.6m in annual profit

Whirlpool App, Native Mobile Application (2022)

Added and refined features to an existing platform by working alongside Whirlpool’s product team.

- Used an agile methodology to work with project stakeholders and developers to consistently iterate and improve features
- Interviewed individual users, updating the UX of the design in response to research insights
- Shipped SSO redesign that reduced login complaints to customer service by 14%
